

RIC Safe

- Local Incidents and Initiatives.
 - Wing Tip Fuel over flow.
 - American aircraft had fuel come out of the overflow valve. American had the spill contained before ARFF arrived on scene.



- Glycol spill in roadway.
 - The GRV sprung a leak as it was driving down the road. It collected the spilled fluid.





FOD

DESCRIPTION: Tower called to report a PIREP of FOD behind the aircraft at gate B15 along with similar FOD at Twys A/E. Ops responded to the area to find an empty aviation oil box along with several empty oil cans. Ops contacted tower and did a sweep of Twys A, E, U, and Rwy 02/20 at E.9 oil cans found in total scattered in all of the mentioned surfaces. Ops started making contact with aviation maintenance personnel. Go Jet reported using the Mobile Aviation Oil that was found and after checking with their personnel found the box they used missing. Ops reminded all involved of the dangers that posed especially since 1 was found on Rwy 02/20 (safety area). As I only found 9 cans there are 3 more likely still in the area. I alerted Delta that a couple empty oil cans may be in their ramp area and to be on the look out.

Southwest De-Icing operators put older ICEMAN into service after finding new trucks were staged for use low on de-icing fluid and fuel (poor operational readiness). Operator left truck to warm up the burners while they left to pick up de-icing tablet for fluid testing and upon arrival back to the truck found flames and smoke emitting from the rear vents. American Airlines staff had called for FIRE response and truck operator called for POLICE response. NAFD quickly contained and extinguished the fire. Airport Ops responded for incident assistance and fluid containment. No injuries. No airport property damage.


