  - Fire breaks out on a Frontier Airliner
  - Tug catches fire in SAO PAULO while towing an aircraft.
    - o No one uses an extinguisher.
  - Pilot dies mid flight
  - Passenger lands plane after pilot suffers medical emergency.
  - Jet pulls into RWY Safety area after landing.
  - Tampa reopens after Milton

#### RIC Safe

- Local Incidents and Initiatives.
  - Tug struck bollards in the south bagroom. Vehicle was speeding.



ARFF responding to the gate 60 area for a HAZMAT spill. Ops on scene with the fuel truck. One of the wheel chocks fell on the 16 gallon "Prist" tank on the side of the truck causing a rupture where all the contents of the container spilled out. ARFF informed of the chemical upon arrival. The area was sprayed down with foam 342 to neutralize and dilute the chemical. The area was vacuumed with the Hazmat Truck. Once the area was cleared, dawn cleaning solution was added to the affected area and then hosed clear. ARFF cleared the scene at 2351.
