Be Aware: Global Entry Event at RIC July 14-18

Richmond International Airport is hosting a temporary Global Entry enrollment event from July 14-18, 2025. Global Entry is a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (USCBP) program that allows expedited clearance for pre-approved, low-risk travelers upon arrival in the United States. Upon arrival to the United States, program participants proceed to automated Global Entry kiosks. After using the kiosk or mobile app, individuals will be

directed to designated Global Entry lines to speak with an officer. On average, Global Entry members wait less than 10 minutes while using this program upon entering the United States. 31 of RIC's nonstop destinations offer Global Entry kiosks!

Unfortunately, the enrollment event is fully booked, so hopefully you already grabbed your spot! USCBP has not ruled out walk-ups, but your spot will not be guaranteed. The event will take place in the Business Center on the upper-level connector between ticketing and the atrium. Interviewees are reminded that there is no charge for parking stays of less than 60 minutes in Hourly or Daily Parking in the decks. Click here to learn more!

Taxiways & Jet Bridges Construction Update

Work continues on taxiways Charlie and Echo's relocations! This project includes the construction of two new stub taxiways, drainage modifications, and the installation of new lighting. The concrete and asphalt demolition are now complete, and electrical demolition is ongoing.

The Passenger Boarding Bridge Replacement Project is also underway, consisting of the removal of twelve passenger boarding bridges in Concourses A and B. Gate A5 has returned to service and Gate A3's jetway installation is underway. Gate A1 is the next gate scheduled for replacement.
