Jet Bridge Replacement

RIC will be replacing 12 jet bridges, some of which are over 35 years old. The replacement will start in mid-July with B-7 and then continue with all the older bridges, completing the replacement of several bridges on Concourse B and all bridges on Concourse A. The remaining bridges on Concourse B will be replaced in the future.

It will take an estimated 30 days to complete each bridge change out. Several of the bridges will require foundation work which will require additional time to complete. During this time, we will be temporarily relocating airlines to nearby or adjacent gates to help facilitate the construction schedule.

The new bridges will have additional security cameras for the safety of our tenants and customers. They will also include additional safety features for employees using the bridges and performing maintenance.

We are looking forward to completing this work to provide a better environment and reliability for our tenants, customers, and employees.
