Art at the Airport

There's new artwork in Baggage Claim! This exhibition comes from <u>Kris Iden</u>, a Richmond artist that specializes in intaglio printmaking. Iden has exhibited both in the U.S. and internationally and has works in VMFA's permanent collection. She is excited about showcasing her 30-year artistic career at RIC. Here's a statement from the artist:

"The process of etching doesn't allow the work to be fully seen until the plates are finally printed. I work in this technology, which is more than 500 years old, with an element of intuition and intention—as well as prior skill and knowledge, of course, but also always a degree of uncertainty and surprise about the final product.

My images spring from reflections—my own or others'—on science, the natural world, and examinations of things in their essence that have analogy and connection to human sensation and experience. The numerous metal plates used in each print contribute structure and interweave imagery of poetic metaphor alluding to Gaston Bachelard's two kinds of space: "intimate space and exterior space . . . keep encouraging each other."" - Kris Iden
