Blue Lightning Initiative

Team RIC is doing their part to end human trafficking! As detailed in RIC's Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Homeland Security, the airport must report to the government the total number of employees trained under the <u>Blue Lightning Initiative (BLI)</u> program (fiscal year 10/1/24 to 9/30/25). **622 individuals received either the BLI Interactive Employee** Training or facilitator-led training! This is a 600% increase from the 81 trainings reported for FY 2024.

Thank you to the Commission's Badging Team for promoting this important training, with a special thanks to Pamela Quarles, Sunnie Fisher, Stephanie McVey, and Jessy Torres, who facilitated a number of classes in person.

Additionally, the human trafficking hotline number has been posted in all terminal restrooms. Please report suspected human trafficking if you observe any of the indicators below.

REPORT HUMAN TRAFFICKING

If you observe the following indicators of suspected human trafficking activity, you should report them right away.



No control of travel identification/documents



No freedom of movement social interaction



Difficulty articulating reasonable/logical



A non-genuine relationship; particularly parent/guardian-child

However, Erica reached out and checked on the gentleman the evening prior to his flight to ensure his well-being, that he had adequate food, and that his family was informed of his return and condition.
